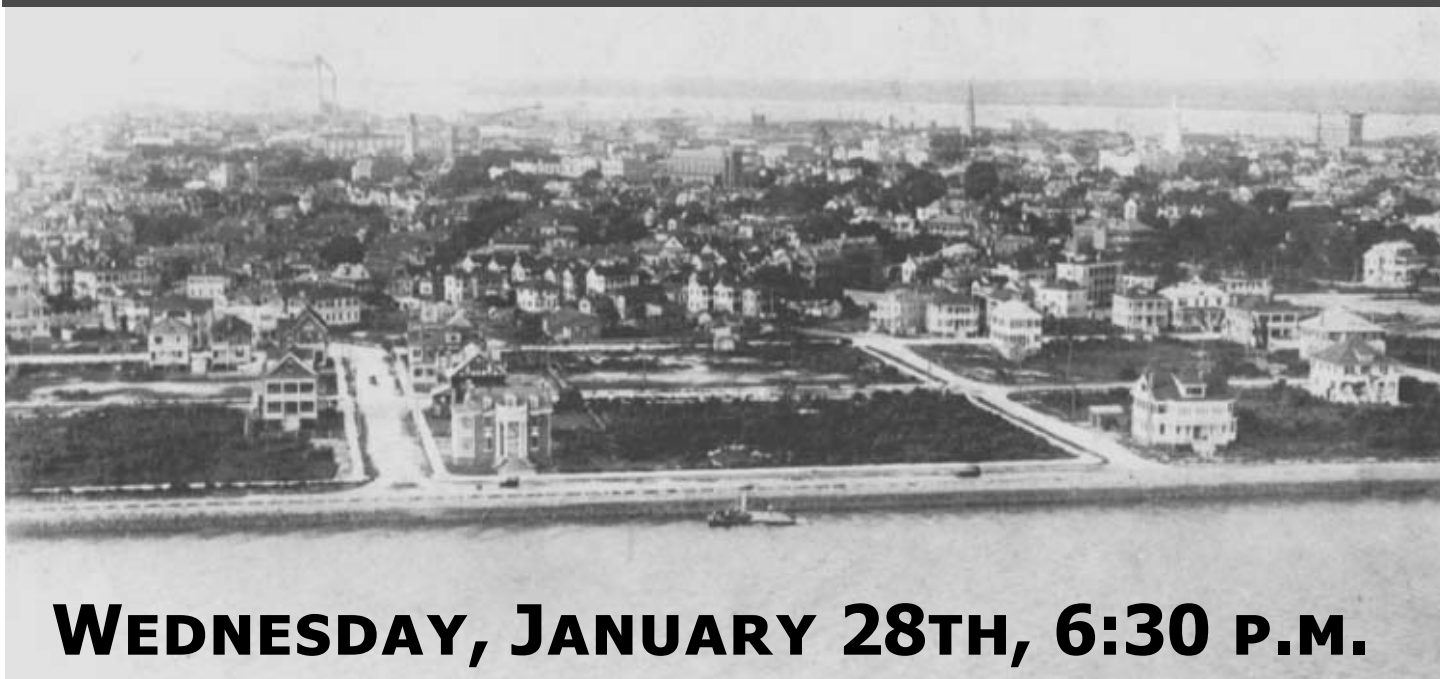


THE CHARLESTON ARCHIVE PRESENTS

Charleston's "Boulevard Project" commenced in 1909, after half a century of planning. The new seawall from East Battery to the west end of Tradd Street created 47 acres of high land for hundreds of homes, but the original plan to continue the Boulevard to Hampton Park was never realized.
